

GUIDELINES

1. Name of award : Han's Animal Life Science Foundation

2. Donor : Hans' Animal Life Science Foundation, Seoul, Korea

3. Nature of award : A monetary award of US\$ 5,000 (five thousand) plus round-trip airfare (economy basis) and an appropriate memento or plaque, to be presented once every five years at the World Conference on Animal Production (WCAP). Local expenses may be covered by organizing committee of each WCAP.

4. Purpose : To recognize and stimulate distinguished service to animal production internationally.

5. Eligibility for nomination

To be eligible for this award, a nominee shall have made a meritorious scientific contribution by way of teaching, research, or other service to animal production over a period of five or more years, and shall have been nominated by 3 members of Associations affiliated to the World Association for Animal Production. Particular attention will be paid to the international significance of the contribution.

6. Award Selection Committee

- 1) The Selection Committee will be coordinated by the Scientific Advisory Committee of WAAP
- 2) The Selection Committee may reject all nominees when, in their opinion, no worthy candidate has been nominated.

7. Material to be supplied by nominator

1. WAAP Award Nomination Form.
2. A dossier that contains the following material :
 - a. Biography of the nominee;
 - b. List of publications, courses taught, and other pertinent credentials;
 - c. Summary statement documenting accomplishments and outlining the major contributions to international animal production on which the nomination is based.
3. A citation of approximately 500 words suitable for presentation at the World Conference on Animal Production.
